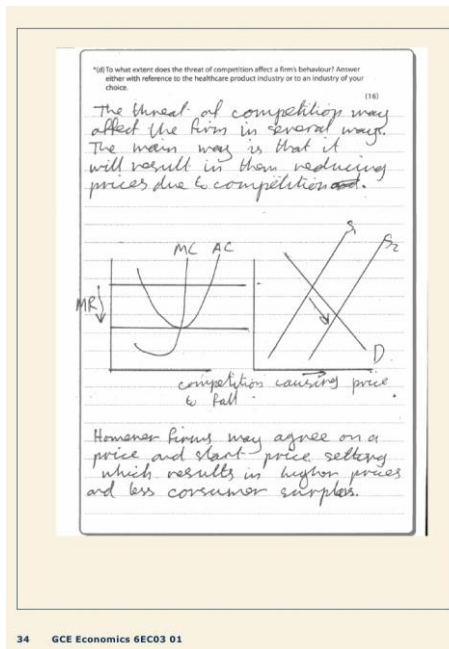


# Write – Review - Right

Skill development drill using examiners reports (or answers that have been executed more successfully than yours) so that you can see the **differences between wrong and right**



# Write – Review - Right

This activity is key for helping you to see the difference between a successful and unsuccessful answer by making you focus on the difference between wrong and right.

# Write – Review - Right

Process: Repeat a tricky task 3 times

You need to see a model of the skill completed successfully (look on Student Share/Sixth Form/ Exam Resources or use the exam boards website). This can be a complex mathematical problem, a perfect paragraph or calculation in Chemistry

You can do this either individual or in a small group

# Write – Review - Right

## What to do:

1. Start off by writing your answer to the question as well as you can. Take your time!
2. Then review your answer by looking at the examiners report (or perfect answer) and examine the differences. Where exactly do you go wrong? What is the result of that error? Where does it lead? How does wrong look different?
3. Then and answer the question right.
